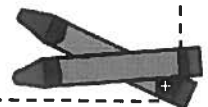

3. Parents may call to request their child's homework on the **second** day of absence.

The theme this month is **safety**. We are still working on the traffic flow during morning drop off and afternoon pick-up. We ask that you please be patient as you enter campus with and for your child.

During morning drop off, please be sure to only let your child out of your vehicle on the curb (passenger side) so that JPOs can assist them to the side walk. We have had a few near misses with children getting out of vehicles on the driver's side of the car while other cars are trying to pass. It is for your child's safety that they only exit and enter the vehicle from the curb side.

Lincoln Elementary School has very limited parking. If you need to park to drop off or pick up your child, you will need to find street parking as our lot is full with faculty vehicles.

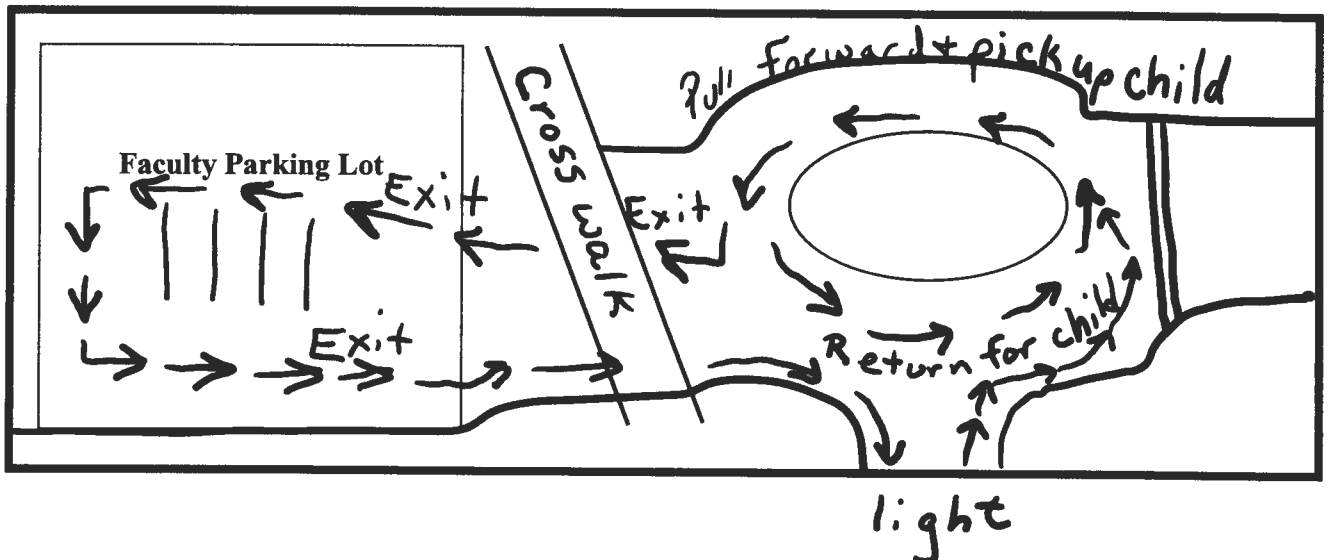
Please remember:
